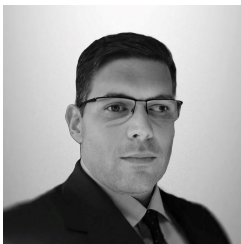
Hasmeet Kaur started her career at Roland Berger in 2013 in India and has since contributed significantly to the development of the business in the
